The New Frontier Social Leisure Club is for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder who would like to participate in socialization activities. Two groups of 15 participants will be staffed by New Frontier personnel. Each activity is planned based on participant suggestions.

The New Frontier Social Leisure Club has three goals: The first is to provide supervised socialization opportunities. The second is to help individuals develop skills and abilities to be able to socialize in group settings. The third is to have members form bonds and build lasting friendships.

Social Leisure Club is presented under the auspices of **ACROSS THE LIFESPAN**, a series of seminars and workshops for individuals on the autism spectrum and their families.
